TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The highest bidder will be the purchaser of each lot. If any dispute occurs, the Auctioneer shall investigate the dispute and may re-sell the disputed lot.
2. Lots become the property of the buyer at the fall of the hammer and their responsibility. Prior to this they are the property and responsibility of the seller.
3. Lots for the auction are accepted in good faith. The description of lots as given by the vendor and Auctioneer is for your guidance only. The Auctioneer does not accept any responsibility arising from the description of lots or give any guarantee. Lots are sold as seen. No electrical lots are accepted except collectibles.
4. We give guidance on reserves and values. These are not valuations. We reserve the right to not sell a seller's proposed lot(s).
5. All lots must be paid for before removal from the auction room(s). Lots will be checked at the door with your buyer's receipt card.
6. The minimum bid is £5.
7. A 12.5% Buyer's premium is applied to all lots purchased. e.g. If you buy a lot with a bid of £10, you pay £11.25
8. A 12.5% Seller's premium is applicable on all lots sold plus £1 listing fee for each lot, whether sold or not. e.g. When a lot sells for £10 the Seller will be paid £7.75. We reserve the right not to pay the Seller until we have received the Buyer's payment.
9. Payments can only be made in cash or cheque & valid cheque card.
10. Lots not claimed at the end of the auction may be disposed of by the Auctioneer unless a prior arrangement has been made.
